Seeding and Landscaping Agreement

Seeding the entire system upon completion is very important. Lack of grass on a system may lead to erosion by wind and rain, exposing the system to the elements. After final inspection it is recommended that seeding occur immediately. Winter wheat or fescue can serve as an intermediary before grass is added if necessary. If seeding is not possible, the area around the system must be covered with straw until seeding occurs.

Further, it is important for proper soil cover to be maintained upon completion of the system. Additional top soil may be required on shallow systems. This cover must be good top soil. The top soil will cap the system and protect it from exposure and possible failure. After inspection by the Health Dept. soil cover over the system must be a minimum of 12 inches. Many installers only provide a rough grade over the system and require the homeowner to do additional dragging and smoothing. If the homeowner conducts the finish grading, be careful not to remove any of the soil cover. Any damage done to the system after the installer leaves is the homeowners responsibility.
